

Ida GOLDSCHMIDT

27 Oct 1880 – 23 Mar 1943

Leo Goldschmidt's sister, **Ida Goldschmidt** was born on 27 Oct 1880 in Stolzenau. On 22 Jun 1926, in Berlin, she married **Adolf Brandt** (b. 3 Jul 1862 in Krotoschin, Posen). Ida was 45 when they married; Adolf was 63. He had been married previously and had a 25 year-old son, Richard Brandt (b. 14 Mar 1891 in Kobylin, Posen). Adolf Brandt is recorded as having been a merchant in Kobylin in 1890.

After their marriage, Ida and Adolf lived in the city of Schwerin, in Mecklenburg, approx. 90 km east of Hamburg. From 1945-1990, this was in the territory of East Germany, and records were more difficult to access than in West Germany. Since re-unification, Schwerin is in the State of Mecklenburg-Vorpommern in the Federal Republic of Germany.

Records show that in 1890 Adolf was a merchant in Kobylin, Posen, and in 1939 he was a pensioner in Schwerin.

Records also show that Adolf was held in 1939 in the Dreibergen-Bützow prison about 60 km northwest of Schwerin. This was a regular prison, not a concentration camp. This was probably related to the Kristallnacht pogrom. His son, Richard, who was also living in Schwerin, was also arrested after Kristallnacht and held at the Alt Strelitz prison from 10 Nov – 23 Dec 1938. After his release from prison, Richard emigrated to Belgium in 1939. He was captured later, and on 26 Sep 1942 was deported from Mechelen (near Antwerp) to Auschwitz, where he perished. He was 51 years old at the time of his death.

Ida and Adolf remained in Schwerin. Three and a half years later, on 11 Nov 1942, they were both arrested and taken to the Dreibergen-Bützow prison and then transferred to the Neustrelitz prison, 82 km to the southeast. At this time Ida was 62 years old and Adolf was 79. They were held in Neustrelitz prison for one week, from 12 Nov - 20 Nov 1942, and then transported via Berlin to the Theresienstadt ghetto.

Adolf survived less than 2 months in Theresienstadt. He died on 7 Jan 1943, at age 79. The reason can be seen on the following Death Notification document. According to the Jewish doctor who certified his death (Dr. Franz Kohn), he was suffering from "enterocolitis", a severe inflammation of the bowels. The document states that his "funeral" took place 2 days later. Presumably, his body was cremated.


